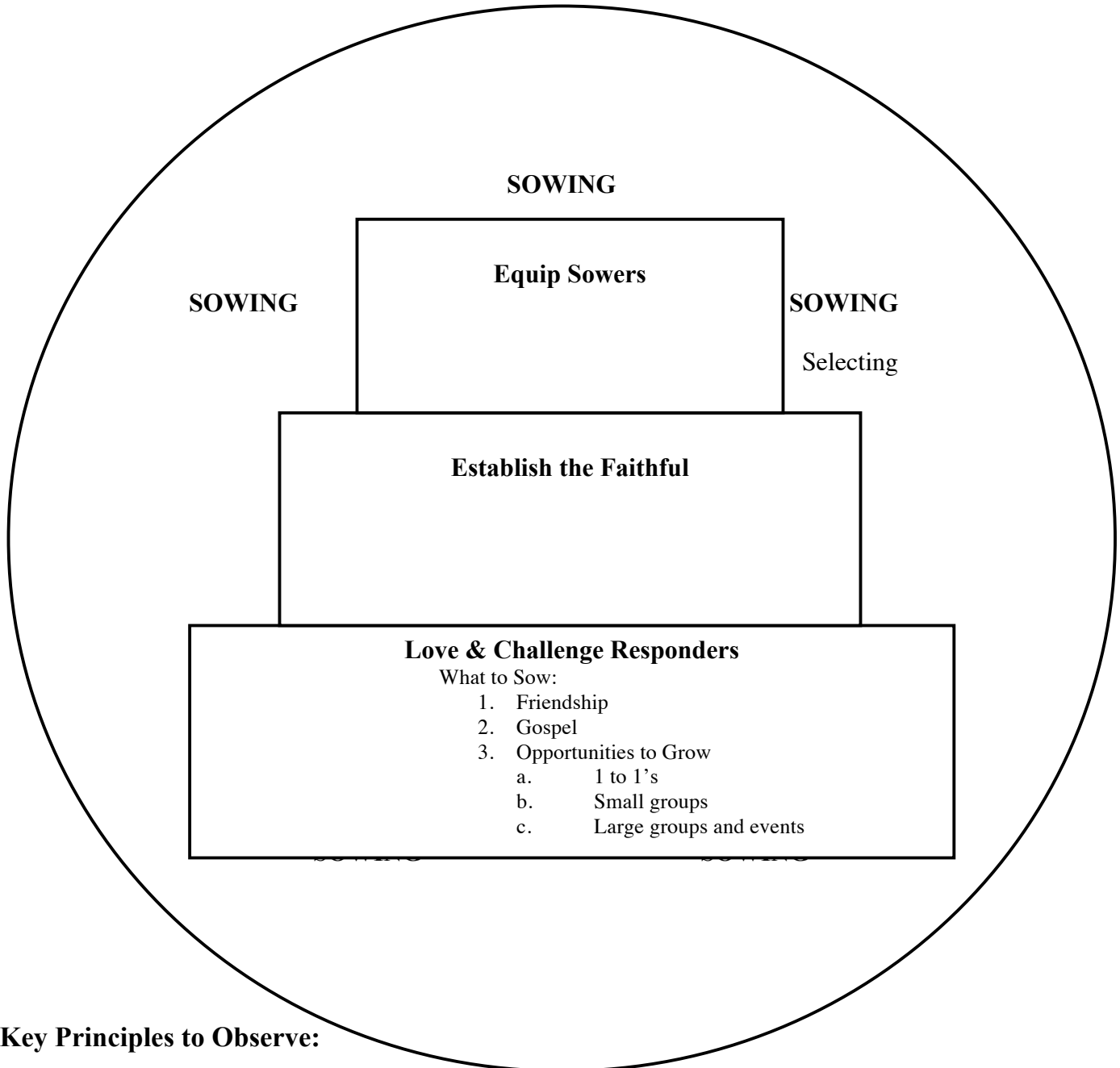


# Overview of the Ministry Process

Sowing, Selecting, and Spiritual Multiplication



## Key Principles to Observe:

1. Sowing is the one ministry activity that is constant. You never finish sowing but rather you are always sowing. Ecc. 11:6
2. A person enters the cake of growth by responding favorably to your sowing (either the gospel or an opportunity to grow). They are called responders.
3. A responder moves up in the cake by responding faithfully to more challenging opportunities to grow (i.e. Bible study with standards, D-Group, growth in the basics of the wheel, etc.)
4. Someone is selected only after they have had a chance to show faithfulness for a period of time while being established in the basics of the wheel as well as taking opportunities to sow themselves. You should seek counsel before selecting. Luke 6:12-13.
5. Sowing is always happening; before they respond, while they are responding and after they respond we should sow with them.
6. Once you have selected, you take them deep in the basics and equip them to sow.
