

## John 10:10 Discussion – How To

After you have shared the gospel, this can help students understand that obedience and trust in Christ leads to a satisfied life - not a deprived one. It also exposes that a lifestyle of sin and distrust in Christ will certainly and eventually lead to destruction.

- Have the student read John 10:10 out loud.
- Tell them Jesus is speaking. Ask: “Who is the thief?” (*Satan/devil*)
- Ask: “What does he come to do?” (*steal, kill destroy*) Write this: **Thief (devil) - steal, kill, destroy**
- Ask: “What do you think steal, kill, and destroy means?” (*dissatisfaction, worry, lack of peace/joy/satisfaction, lowest point, fear, lack of purpose, destroy your heart, mind, life, and joy bit by bit*)
- Ask: “Jesus says he comes so that we can have what?” (*abundant or full life*)
- Ask: “What does this mean?” Explain abundant life means satisfaction, purpose, hope, joy, security, and peace, which is everything everyone searches for in this life. Write this: **Jesus - abundant life**
- Explain that the Bible says that Satan deceives, so his packages always make his options look attractive. They never look like the death and destruction that they are. They don’t look like stealing, killing, and destroying. Either immediately or down the road, you will always regret his path.
- OPTION: ask them if they can see any area where Satan is leading them to death and destruction... discuss that more.
- Point out the two options you wrote down. Ask the student which path they think they are on currently in their life.
- Ask them if they want to put their trust in Christ.
